2020 Trustee Election

Candidate Nominations

Nominations for the 2020 King Country Electric Power Trust election closed at 4pm, Friday 17 January 2020.

6 nominations have been received for the three vacancies on the Trust. The candidates are:

COSFORD, Graeme Selwyn	(Taumarunui)
DOYLE, Adie	(Taumarunui)
DRYDEN, Johnny	(Taumarunui)
KROLL, Uwe	(Ohakune)
WINDELL, Jacques	(Taumarunui)

The area administered by the Trust (the District) is divided into 3 representative areas. The Trust Deed recommends that where possible each area should have at least one elected representative. Uwe Kroll is the current trustee representing the Ohakune area and as his is the only nomination for that area, I therefore declare Uwe Kroll elected unopposed as a trustee for the King Country Electric Power Trust.

As there are more candidates for the other positions than remaining vacancies, an election will be held by postal and internet voting under the First Past the Post electoral system. Voting papers and information about the candidates will be sent to eligible consumers on Friday 7 February 2020. Candidate names will be listed in alphabetical order on the voting documents.

All King Country Electric Power Trust consumers connected to the network as at Friday 27 December 2019 are eligible to vote and will receive one vote only per consumer. Where consumers are listed in joint or entity names they will be entitled to appoint a representative to exercise the vote on behalf of the entity or joint consumers.

Voting closes at 12 noon on Wednesday 26 February 2020.
