Nominations slow for King Country Trust's Election of Trustees

With one week before nominations close for King Country Trust's election of trustees, candidates are proving slow to put their names forward.

As of today, Tuesday 12 December 2023, no nominations have been received for the three vacancies.

Candidates have until 4pm on Wednesday 20 December 2023 to get their nominations in.

To be eligible for nomination, a candidate must be aged over 18 years, be a consumer of electricity and be recorded on the Electoral Roll within the King Country Trust district. Each candidate must have two (2) people support their nomination, who are also consumers of electricity within the King Country Trust district.

Nomination papers are available by accessing <u>www.kcpowertrust.co.nz</u> where one can be downloaded, or by contacting the Returning Office at <u>info@electionservices.co.nz</u> or 0800 922 822 to have one posted or emailed out.

Nominations must be received by 4pm on Wednesday 20 December 2023.

If more than three nominations are received, an election will be held by postal and electronic voting, with voting packs issued to electricity consumers in the King Country Trust district from Friday 26 January 2024.
